The program promotes self-sufficiency and family stability through individual and group counseling, educational services, assistance with prenatal care, and support services.

The coordinator, Karla Boyce, offers community resource referrals which provides case management support including the following:

- Family planning
- Parenting classes
- Job skills training
- Public benefits such as SNAP and WIC
- Health services for mother, father, and child, both before and after birth
- Education
